

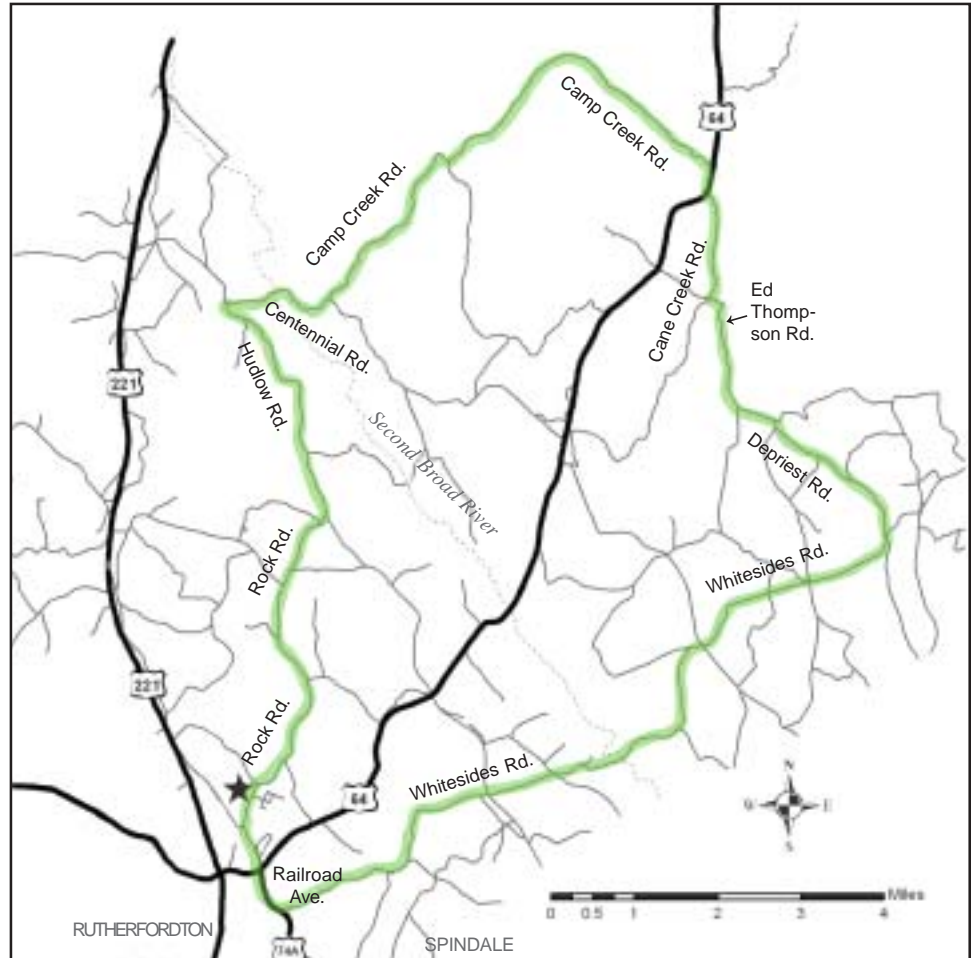
## Route #1 Camp Creek Loop – 34.2 miles

A beautiful ride with views of mountains for most of the time. No major climbs, but plenty of undulating, lightly traveled roads. DePriest makes a right hand turn and stays as DePriest, but changes to Thompson as you stay straight a short while later. Several historic markers along the way include Gilbert Town (18th Century County Seat) and the Overmountain Trail on Rock Rd. and the Biggerstaff Hanging Tree on Whitesides less than a mile before DePriest.

### Route Directions

Total Mileage (Miles in segment)

- Start: Tanner. From parking return to Rock Road (0.2)
- 0.2 R on Rock Road (1.4)  
S across US 64 onto US 74A (Railroad Ave.)  
This is a busy intersection!
- 1.6 L on Whitesides (9.8)  
Straight at stop sign at Hudlow  
Cross Second Broad River
- 11.4 L on DePriest (at 2.1 stay R on DePriest) (2.5)
- 13.9 S or R on Ed Thompson (1.5)
- 15.4 R on Cane Creek (no road sign at last check!) (1.3)
- 16.7 R on US 64 (0.2)
- 16.9 L on Camp Creek (no road sign at last check!) (6.8)
- 25.7 R on Centennial (1.4)
- 27.1 L on Hudlow (3.1)
- 30.2 R on Rock Rd. (4.0)
- 34.2 R at Tanner and return to parking lot.



### Start from Tanner Parking Lot

From US 221: Turn east on Broyhill Road near R-S Central High School north of Rutherfordton. Take Broyhill Road to Rock Road and turn right. Turn right just past the Rails-to-Trails and go past the Tanner Stores and the Boardwalk Restaurant and park in the far corner of the lot near the Rails-to-Trails.
